

Mathematics Consultant

The **Mathematics Consultant** will assist in providing leadership and coordination within the AMA ESD districts. He/she will carry out responsibilities related to mathematics professional development, curricular alignment and programs for students, administrators and teachers in the AMA ESD. He/she will provide consultative services in K-12 mathematics and related areas to improve the learning for all children in schools throughout the AMA ESD. This includes the following duties and responsibilities:

1. Serve as a mathematics consultant to area school districts and meet on a regular basis with math teachers and coordinators.
2. Provide professional development and support teachers in the use of various mathematic programs such as MMPI, Delta, Easy CBM Math, etc.
3. Provide a leadership role and assist school districts in aligning teaching to the Common Core State Standards and best practices in mathematics.
4. Assist with the articulation between elementary, junior high, and high school mathematics programs.

Minimum Qualifications:

- A master's degree and a valid Michigan teaching certificate. Minimum of five (5) years' experience with teaching elementary, middle school or high school math. Consulting experience preferred.
- Ability to work independently and make decisions in the absence of supervisors and to prioritize jobs.
- Willingness to undergo in-service training and additional education as needed.
- Strong computer skills.
- Proficiency in written and oral communication.
- The ability to work cooperatively with other agencies.
- Strong organizational skills.
